DIRTY for GOOD 2021 Situational Trail Training/ Fund Raising Tour will take place on the NorthEast Back Country Discovery Route. It is designed for riders with intermediate dual sport / adventure riding skills who have had formal dual sport/adventure rider training within the 2021 riding season.

Please understand & verify that you subscribe to life-long learning and meet the requirements to be successful with the Dual Sport Motorcycle Trail Training Tour. See attached descriptions of Skill Levels & Terrain these skills involve.

DIRTY for GOOD riding days will involve 6-8 hours per day of riding. Much of the riding involves standing up on the motorcycle's pegs while using body positioning for turns, surmounting obstacles, water crossings, uphill and downhill terrain as well as mud, sand, gravel, and rocks. Dual Sport / Adventure riding requires stamina, good health, physical fitness, balance, agility, mental alertness & the ability to focus on & follow instructions.

You can **ONLY** be successful if you meet these requirements, have a motorcycle endorsement on your driver's license & are willing to learn. We share these realities, not to intimidate you or scare you away from this training tour, but to ensure that you understand what it takes to have a successful, enjoyable experience.

The next portion provides what your registration fee covers. You will then be asked you to provide information regarding your dual sport/adventure rider training and riding experience. Thank you for your honest self-assessments.

Please carefully read each item below. Indicate your understanding and compliance with each item by checking its box:

- I meet the physical & mental requirements to participate & will come to DIRTY for GOOD rested & ready to learn. I will bring my license with motorcycle endorsement to the DIRTY for GOOD Rider Training Tour.
- I will come to the DIRTY for GOOD Situational Trail Training Tour with the proper riding gear: DOT approved full-face, modular, or dual sport/dirt riding helmet, eye protection (goggles or face shield), chest/back protection, elbow/shoulder protection, full-length riding pants with armor or separate knee/shin/hip protection, dirt-Dual Sport or Adventure Riding boots, full-fingered gloves, hydration (water) system.

- I understand the registration fee of is \$1200. A \$400/non-refundable but transferable deposit is required to hold one's spot. This will provide me with lodging (2/room), breakfast, healthy trail snacks, rides guides, Situational Trail Riding Instruction, t-shirt, retro-reflective tour stickers, drayage for luggage and sleeping bag and, downloadable GPX/GPS routes. Final payment must be made by August 1, 2021.

Once we receive your registration, you will receive an invoice for \$1200. This \$400 non-refundable but transferrable deposit holds your spot. Final payment is due August 1, 2021. As with DIRTY for GOOD 2020, postponed due to Covid-19, or for any reason, should DIRTY for GOOD 2021 be cancelled. All deposits/payments will be refunded.

I understand I must bring a street legal Dual Sport/Adventure bike to training. I understand I need a minimum of 90% remaining tread on my tires. Optimally, tires should be rated 60% dirt / 40% and at a minimum 50% road 50% dirt to provide you the best traction for varying conditions. You must provide a current registration or rental paperwork for the model you bring to the tour.

**Bigger is NOT better for training.** You should be comfortable with the size, weight, and power of the motorcycle you bring. A 250c.c. – 400c.c., lightweight dual sport model is a fine choice for training on the North East Backcountry Discovery Route. Your motorcycle should be equipped with hand guards, skid plate & depending on the model, engine guards along with protective equipment for other vulnerable parts of your model of motorcycle.
